Transportation Options for Eddystone Borough Residents

SHARED RIDE PROGRAM

Delaware County residents have an economical, safe, efficient, curb-to-curb transportation option.

With one call the day before transportation is needed, you can arrange to share a ride with others in a bus or van within multiple service areas in Delaware County. Destinations to Philadelphia and other surrounding counties are available on a more limited basis.

Reduced-fare transportation is available for mature adults, age 65 and older, thanks to Pennsylvania State Lottery proceeds. Other transportation subsidies for individuals are also available through various agencies.

If you are 65 years of age or older and are a resident of the Borough of Eddystone, you are eligible for FREE transportation to Eddystone Crossing Shopping Center whose stores include Shop Rite and WalMart! Transportation is courtesy of Eddystone Borough!

Please note that this is a pilot program and Eddystone Borough Council may opt to open the program up to more destinations and residents at a later date.

If you are eligible, please complete the attached request for information card or stop by the Eddystone Borough Building to pick up a registration packet.

When you complete your registration packet, you will be required to provide one of the following types of proof of age:

- Birth or baptismal certificate
- State issued Driver's license
- PA Photo Identification Card
- INS Resident Alien Card
- Veteran's Universal Access ID Card
- Armed forces discharge papers
- PACE or PACENET CARD
- Passport or Naturalization Papers

We cannot accept your Medicare Card.

When your registration documents are received by Community Transit, they will mail you a personalized rider ID card that you must show to the driver each time you ride.
