



Eddystone Borough COVID-19 Statement Update 3/20/2020

In response to the COVID-19 virus, Eddystone Borough has declared a State of Emergency.

We've implemented the following measures:

3/14/2020:

- Out of an abundance of caution, all Borough sponsored events will be canceled.
- To promote social distancing as prescribed by State officials, public access to all Borough buildings will be restricted to the police entrance on 12th Street ONLY.
- All essential personnel will report to work as usual.
- Police patrols will continue 24/7 as usual.
- EMT hours have been expanded.
- Trash will continue to be collected as usual.
- Building permits will be issued for emergency projects ONLY.

3/20/2020:

- We are following Governor Wolf's directive that all non life sustaining businesses are closed until further notice.
- The Easter Egg hunt Scheduled for April 4th 2020 is canceled.
- The Eddystone Borough Council Workshop meeting scheduled for Monday April 6th 2020 at 7 P.M. is canceled.
- Payment for local borough taxes will be accepted by U.S. Mail. The discount period has been extended until April 30th 2020.
- Any Senior Citizens experiencing difficulty with obtaining their required prescribed medications should contact borough hall at 610-874-1100 for assistance.

These restrictions will remain in effect until Monday, April 12th, 2020 at 8:00 am. The Borough will continue to coordinate with County, State and Federal agencies to modify these measures accordingly.
