To promote health and safety to the members of the community and to help ensure the continuity of emergency police services, the Eddystone Police Department will suspend the practice of processing parking ticket payments or police reports in person. We will process those requests in the following manner.

- **Call 911 to speak to an officer for all Emergency and Non-Emergencies.**
- **Call 610.874.9325 for general information (Monday – Friday from 8 AM-4 PM).**
- **Parking tickets**- drop in mail slot for processing; a receipt will be mailed or emailed (only if an email address is on the remittance) to you, upon request.
- **Parking Permits**- application requests are to be emailed to kkrisac@eddystonepd.com.
- **Accident Reports**- will be available via Crashdocs.org
- **Police Reports** -will be addressed through an email request to kkrisac@eddystonepd.com
