Police Response regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19)

The Eddystone Police department will still respond to calls and patrol the borough, though it will attempt to limit in-person contact if possible.

Out of an abundance of caution, the Eddystone Police Department is implementing new procedures in response to the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic. The purpose is to ensure the health and safety of our community as public safety is our number one priority. The Eddystone Police Department and other law enforcement agencies have procedures in place to provide mutual aid on a local level should law enforcement agencies have staffing issues due to illness.

For emergency and non-emergency calls, residents will continue to call 911. Non-emergency calls will be handled over the phone. Police response will be addressed as needed. Police Officers will make every effort to have limited contact with the public “for the safety and protection of the community members and police officers.”
